

Statement on Subway's Support of Those Impacted by the War in Ukraine

Our thoughts are with the people of Ukraine, and we are committed to supporting those impacted by the tragic events in the region. Subway is making monetary donations to several humanitarian organizations including <u>Polish Humanitarian Action</u>, <u>Voices of Children</u> and the <u>Organization for Aid to</u> <u>Refugees</u>, amongst others.

As background, Subway has no corporately owned restaurant operations in Russia. There are approximately 450 franchised restaurants in Russia which are all independently owned and operated by local franchisees and managed by an independent master franchisee, not Subway corporate employees. The master franchisee manages all operations, marketing and the supply chain. Subway does not directly control these independent franchisees, nor their restaurants, and has limited insight into their day-to-day operations. Subway is committed to not make any direct investments nor open any company-owned restaurants in Russia and is redirecting profits from operations in Russia to humanitarian efforts.
